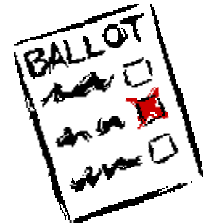
Below is the slate of officers to be voted on during the June business meeting. If you wish to be included on this slate, you must be present at the business meeting.
