His service to our youth and his families involvement in many of our events as well as parish and community events makes his family stand out as a great Knight family!

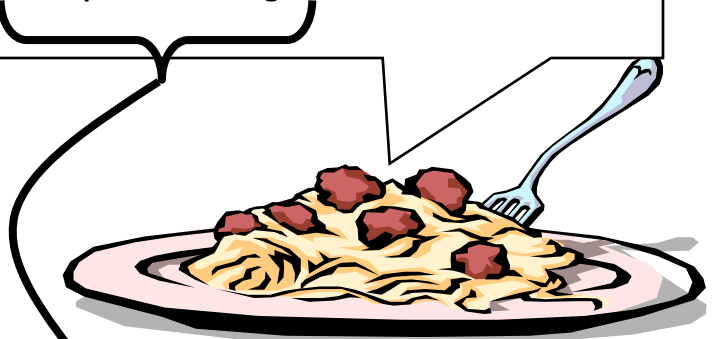
