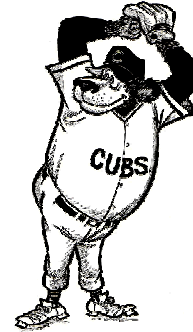


## Reds Trip — Reds vs. Cubs
